#### QUALIFICATIONS

In order to qualify an applicant must already be a certified police officer in the State of New Jersey or has successfully completed a police training course through a PTC approved alternate route program or an academy substantially equivalent to the requirements required for certification by the police training commission. (N.J.S.A. 52:17B-66, et seq.)

In addition;

- Applicants must be between 18 and 35 years of age,
- Possess a minimum of 60 college credits from an accredited college or university; or four years active duty service from any branch of the U.S. Military, be a resident of NJ, possess a valid driver's license from any state, and be a United States citizen.
