Prepare a well-reasoned and researched paper on any one of the following topics:

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RESEARCH PAPER TOPICS

1. Prepare a well-reasoned argument for the proposition that the actions of NATO in Libya exceeded U.N. Resolution 1973 and violates International Law.
2. Prepare a well-reasoned argument for the proposition that members of the PLO and Hamas presently in Israeli jails for attacks against military targets are entitled to POW status under the Geneva Conventions.
3. Identify those international crimes for which U.S. officials could be liable under international law and describe the problems associated with their possible prosecution in connection with the treatment of prisoners at Abu Ghraib and Guantanamo.
4. Develop a constitutional challenge to the Anti-Terrorism Act of 1987. See for example *Mendelsohn v Meese*, 65 F Supp 1474 (1988).
